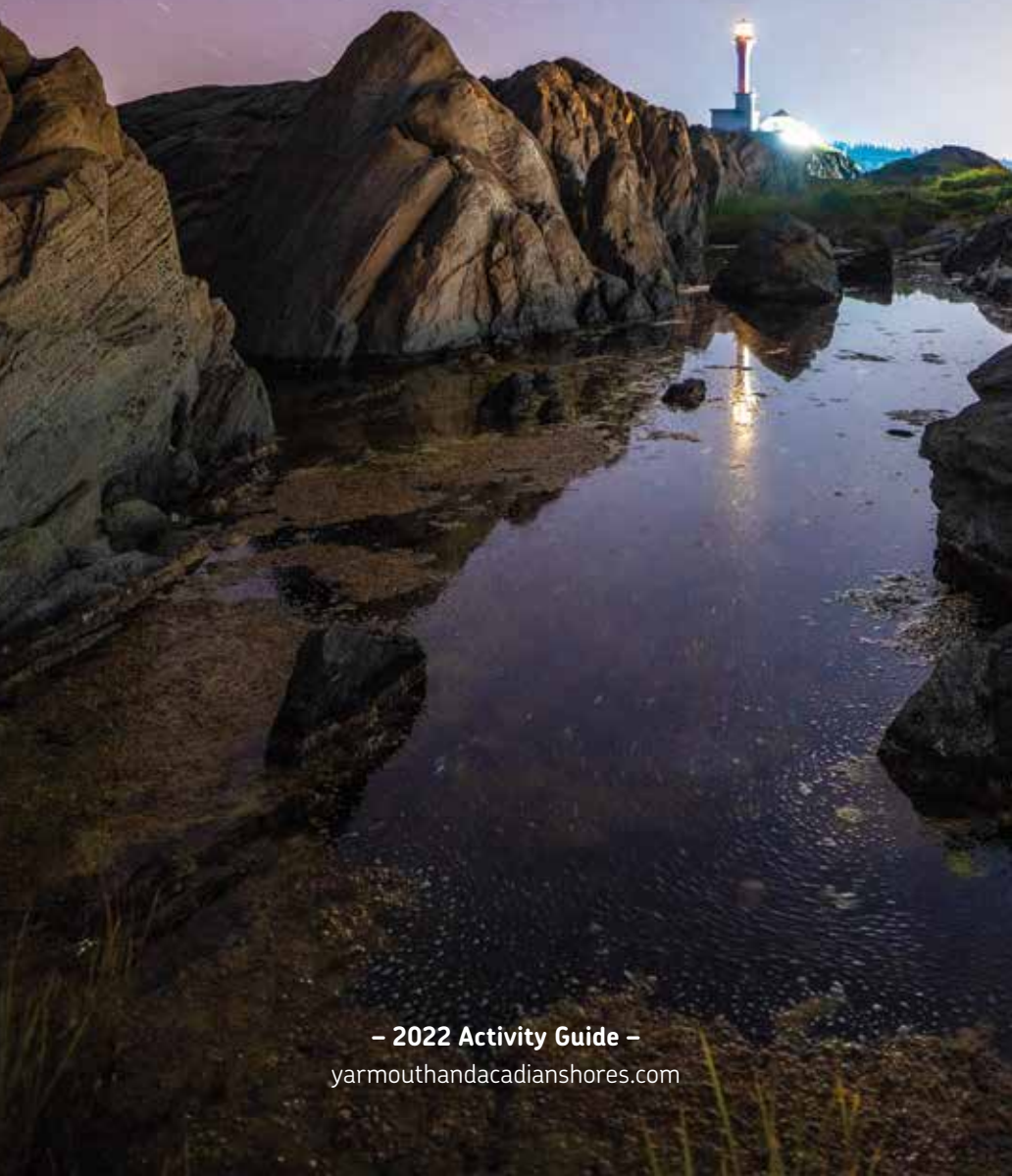

Welcome to Cape Forchu, a Light Like No Other. This spectacular "apple core" lighthouse is the second most photographed lighthouse in Nova Scotia and located just 10 minutes outside the Town of Yarmouth.

The Cape has been welcoming visitors since 1604, when explorer Samuel de Champlain named the area "Cap Fourchu," meaning "forked tongue of land." Towering over the jagged coastline since 1839, the Cape Forchu Light welcomes people to the region and beckons them to shore. With crashing waves and sprawling skies, it's no wonder Cape Forchu was voted one of the best public spaces in Canada.

When visiting be sure to browse the gift shop located inside the former light keeper's dwelling. Take a walk along the Leif Erikson Park & Trail and explore the rugged landscape while taking in breathtaking views, stunning sunsets and spectacular stargazing.

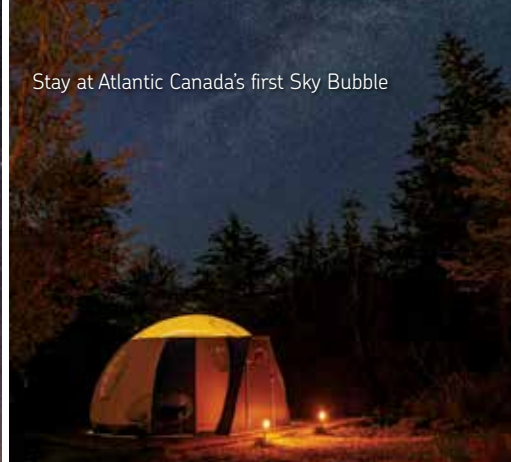

Heritage in Your Hand

Visit the Yarmouth Visitor Information Centre at 341 Main Street and pick up your own copy of the Heritage in Your Hand walking tour guide.

On your walking tour you will pass by close to 200 Sea Captain's or Ship Owner's homes. Many still operate as single-family dwellings, although some function as apartments. These homes, as well as the architecture of the downtown, are a testament to the wealth accumulated during the ship building era.

Historic District Sea Captains' Homes & Mercantile Heritage Walk

Grand sea captains' homes are a testament to the sea and the wealth it generated. These beautifully preserved examples of Queen Anne, Gothic Revival, Georgian, and vernacular architecture were built between 1850 and 1900. Pick up a copy of the Heritage Walking Tour Brochure at one of our Visitor Information Centres.

The Tobeatic Wilderness Area

With dozens of remote lakes, the "Toby" and the adjacent Kejimikujik National Park and National Historic Site together protect 142,000 hectares of mixed woods, barrens and wetlands. It's the wild soul of the Maritimes and the heart of the **UNESCO Southwest Nova Biosphere Reserve**.

The Tobeatic's interconnected lakes, streams and rivers offer outstanding wilderness canoeing, angling and camping opportunities. This storied region of Nova Scotia is best known for its mainland moose, trout streams and rugged canoe routes through rocky lakes and wild rivers. These routes and portages, first travelled by the Mi'kmaq, supported a world-class "sportman's" guiding tradition through the late 19th and early 20th century. They include much of the "Tent Dwellers" canoe route, made famous by Albert Bigelow Paine's 1908 account of back country guiding and sportfishing adventures in this region. Because the region is remote, a licensed guide is recommended. Visit novascotia.com for more information.

Kayaking the Tusket Islands

To paddle around the Tusket Islands is to step back in time. This is one of the few places in Nova Scotia where offshore islands are still used as fishing outposts for an active fishing industry. Local farmers also use the islands to graze their sheep. While this area's waters are shallow, with many islands and shoals, the current is extremely strong along this coast. Where it is necessary to cross open water to access the islands, the Tusket Islands are only suitable for advanced kayakers. Nearby, the more sheltered Lobster Bay is great for beginner and novice kayakers.

Did You Know...

At the turn of the century, these islands had dozens of lobster canneries, a barber, tanner, cobbler, post office and even a pool hall. People no longer live full-time on the Tusket Islands, but the descendants of those early residents still spend time at the shanties that dot the coastline. Today, the Tusket Islands are primarily used as a base for the lobster fishery.

Argyle Scenic Cycling Route

First, enjoy a relaxing ride past the communities of Arcadia and Pleasant Lake. The community of Tusket boasts a steel-covered bridge and Canada's oldest standing courthouse & gaol. Église Ste-Anne Church, built in 1900 in Ste-Anne-du-Ruisseau, The Lost at Sea Memorial, the Musée acadien ("Acadian Museum"), the Village historique acadien de la N.-É. ("Nova Scotia's Acadian Historical Village"), and the wind farm in West Pubnico are other must-see attractions.

1. Head east on Forest St.
2. Left onto Haley Rd.
3. Right at traffic light onto Hwy 3
Side note: a right onto Route 334 in Arcadia will take you to the Acadian regions of Wedgeport, Little River Harbour & Comeau's Hill.
4. Follow until Hwy 103 junction.
5. Right onto Hwy 103. Cross Argyle River.
6. After bridge, take left turn to re-join Route 3
7. Right onto the Argyle Sound Rd.
8. Right onto Hwy 335 into West Pubnico

Return Routes

Return Route 1.

1. Go back through Pubnico on route 335 and take a left on route 3
2. Re-trace trail back to Yarmouth

Return Route 2.

1. Go back through Pubnico on route 335 until you reach Highway 103. Follow until Yarmouth.

Cape Forchu Cycling Route

Route 304 twists and turns along Yarmouth Harbour, offering ocean vistas and views of tidal activity. The route follows a narrow point of land as it juts out into the Atlantic Ocean, culminating at mainland Nova Scotia's most westerly point: Cape Forchu Lightstation.

Tusket Island Tours Deep-Sea Fishing Charters



Deep-Sea Fishing Charter

We offer a deep-sea fishing charter from the Wedgeport wharf (where our large tour boat is located) in our 25' centre console vessel that we use to catch cod and haddock. This tour is dependent on the tide, so times vary and the trip usually lasts 4.5 hours.

Cost is \$150 (tax incl.) per person. A 2-person minimum is required. At the end of the day, we fillet the fish for you so you can take it home and enjoy a delicious fish fry!

For an extra fee of \$150, tax included (total, not per person), we can make a stop on Big Tusket Island and clean and cook your catch of haddock, provided that the facilities are available that day.

(For this tour, the cost is per person and you may be joined by another group if you are part of a small party).

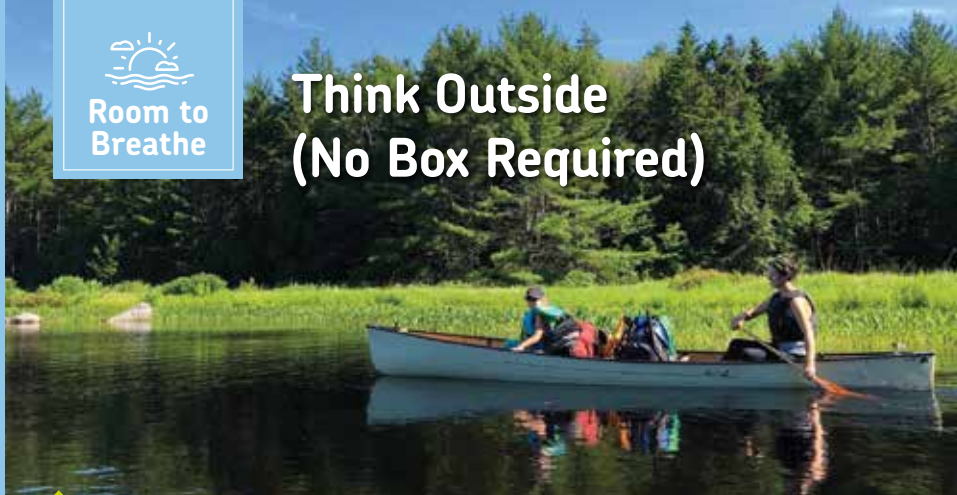

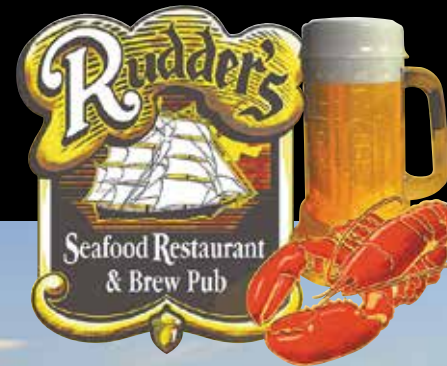
